Call for Papers: CENSUSES, STATISTICS AND DATABASES

One of the sources used to describe mass phenomena, especially in past societies, are censuses. With the passage of time and the development of statistical institutions, many countries published statistical data on specific domains (demography, economy, climate) in the form of statistical yearbooks at periodic intervals. Researchers of the past populations (historians, demographers, economists, biologists, epidemiologists) use this data, collect and store them in databases. Although currently many European and non-European countries can are proud of having large historical demographic databases created on the basis of various sources available in archives, their construction and comparison are still complicated and time-consuming.

CENSUSES, STATISTICS, AND DATABASES for past societies are the subject of the special issues of 40th volume of the journal Studia Historiae Oeconimicae (SHO). **Theoretical and empirical studies are welcome.**

Proposed issues:

- censuses and statistical institution in the past
- procedures of recording information and forms of data handling and data coding
- type of statistics (population, housing, economic, etc.)
- quality and reliability of historical census statistics
- use of censuses in studies of demographic behaviour and biological status of past societies
- popularization of databases for historical populations
- inspirations for future studies.
